CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Blue/Red schooling class is a practice class, can be ridden as many times as needed BEFORE your chosen division, and may be limited to 3 trips.

Lead Line: Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into walk. Ages 8 and under.

Walk & Walk Equitation Open to any horse/rider combination. May cross enter into leadline. Ages 8 and under.

Walk Trot Ground Rails Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four rails on the ground. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. May cross enter into walk trot cross rails. **May be split.**

Walk Trot Cross Rails Fences 12" Open to beginner riders only. To be judged on manners, suitability and ability to guide the mount over a course of four cross rails. May cross enter into walk trot ground rails. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control. **May be split.**

Canter Cross Rails Fences 12" Open to any horse/rider combination. Suitability to count. Equitation to be judged on rider position, hands, seat, leg and control.

Short/Long Stirrup Hunter Fences 2' Short Stirrup-12 & under, Long Stirrup-13 & over with limited experience. May cross into Beginner Rider or Low Intermediate. May be split if necessary.

Beginner Rider Hunter Fences 2' Open to horses or ponies ridden by Juniors or Amateurs with limited experience. To be judged on performance. May cross enter into Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup or Low Intermediate.

Extremely Green Horse Fences 18" Open to horses/ponies of any age who have never jumped in classes exceeding 2'3". No more than SIX entries to canter at one time. May cross enter into any other division not to exceed 2'3" that they are otherwise eligible for. Breaking to trot and slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized. Horses/ponies may enter this division for two years.

Extremely Green Rider Fences 18" Open to riders who have never jumped in classes exceeding 2'3". No more than SIX entries to canter at one time. Breaking to trot and slight mistakes will not be heavily penalized. May cross enter into Canter Cross Rails and, if eligible, Extremely Green Hunter.

Very Green Hunter Fences 2'3" Open to horses in their first two years of showing over fences (not dependent on the horse/rider combination). Judged on performance and soundness. Simple changes of lead not to be penalized. May cross enter into any eligible hunter division that is in compliance with the 3" back-to-back fence height rule.

Low Intermediate Hunter Fences 2'3" Open to Juniors and Amateurs. To be judged on performance. Juniors may cross into Beginner Rider, Short Stirrup, Long Stirrup, Intermediate or Low Children's. Amateurs may cross enter into Beginner Rider, Intermediate, Long Stirrup or Low Adult. Horse/Rider combinations may also cross into Open, OTTB, or if eligible, Very Green.

Low Adult Hunter Fences 2'3" Open to Amateur riders 18 years or older. Horse/rider combination may

cross nominate into MHJA Adult, Intermediate, Low Intermediate, OTTB, Open, or, if rider eligible, Long Stirrup.

Intermediate Hunter Fences 2'6" Open to Juniors or Amateurs. To be judged on performance and soundness. Juniors can cross into Children's Hunter (horse), Low Intermediate, Low Children's or Open. Amateurs can cross enter into Low Adult, Adult, Low Intermediate, Adult Amateur or Open.

Low Children's/Adult Hunter Fences 2'6" Open to Juniors. To be judged on performance and soundness. May cross enter into Low Intermediate, Intermediate, Children's Hunter (horse), Open, or if eligible, Very Green.

Children's Hunter Fences 2'9" To be shown by Junior exhibitors. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Intermediate, Low Children's, OTTB or Open, if eligible.

Children's Hunter Pony Sections are limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under ridden by a Junior Exhibitor not showing over fences exceeding 3' at that show. Ponies to be shown by Junior Exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. Large ponies to jump 2'6". Medium ponies 2'3", Small ponies 2'. All spreads are not to exceed fence heights. Riders in this division are eligible for Children's Hunter Pony Equitation.

Adult Amateur Hunter Fences 2'9" - 3' To be shown by riders who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Spreads not to exceed fence heights. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into MHJA Adult, Intermediate, OTTB, Open and Pre-Green, if eligible.

OTTB Hunter Fences 3', 2'9" or 2'6". Open to Thoroughbred horses that have a visible lip tattoo or proper documentation. Judged on an even hunting pace, manners and jumping style. May cross enter into any eligible hunter division that is in compliance with the 3" back-to-back fence height rule.

Open Hunter: Open to any pony, horse/rider combination. Fences 2'3"-2'6" or 2'9"-3'

Pleasure Division Open to all riders on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance with emphasis on manners and suitability. May be asked to halt and back. Entries in the Hunter Hack class will walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring and will then be asked to jump two fences. Fences 2'.

Schooling Hunter Open to any pony/horse/rider combination. Fences 2'6", 2'3", 2', 18"

Special Hunter Open to any pony/horse/rider combination. Fences 2', 2'3", 2'6", 2'9", 3'

Equitation Classes: Adult. / age 15-17. 2'6. Under age 14. 2'3.

Short/Long Stirrup Equitation Open only to riders in Short/LongStirrup Hunter. Fence height 2'.

Canter Cross Rails Equitation Open only to riders in Canter Cross Rails Hunter. Fence height 12".

Walk Trot Equitation Open only to riders in Walk Trot (Ground Poles or Cross Rails) May be split.

\$100 Fair Haven Farms Hunter Derby: Open to any Junior or Amateur rider on a horse or pony. Fence heights 2', 2'3, 2'6, 2'9. No more than three entries per rider. Each horse/rider combination must show in at least one hunter division at 2' and above at this show to be eligible for the derby. To be judged on performance, hunter style, brilliance and handiness. Course will be designed to show horse and rider ability to perform over traditional hunter obstacles such as walls, gates, brush, roll tops, natural obstacles and oxers. May include bending lines, trot fences and roll backs. The class will be conducted as a two round competition and judged by the open numerical system. The first round will be a hunter style course judged on performance and hunter style. The second round will be a shortened course judged on handiness and brilliance. The first round of each height will return to jump the second (handy) round in reverse order of their scores from the first round, lowest score going first. Scores from both rounds will be combined to determine the winners. Exclusive ribbons go to 8th place. Formal attire is accepted. *Must have at least 8 entries* Must declare entry before 12:00 pm day of Derby. **1st Place \$50 and Prize, 2nd: \$25, 3rd \$15, 4th: \$10**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PRE ENTRIES: \$20/class only if postmarked by the **Monday** before each show. Pre-entries *must* be accompanied by credit card info. Leadline and walk classes \$15 ea.

POST ENTRIES AND ADDS: \$25/class if postmarked **after** the Monday before each show. Your entries and adds are welcome the day of the show. You must Provide your credit card number on your entry.

Negative Coggins within 12 months, and within 6 months for Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino pneumonitis) before back numbers can be issued.

STALLS:

Permanent stalls are available- \$75 for weekend (**a horse must show both days to reserve a weekend stall or a \$75 non showing fee will be added per day**), \$65 for overnight, \$50 for day stall. \$20 for day shipper fee. **\$75 non showing fee per day**. Shavings are available for \$10/bag. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Weekend stalls have priority over overnight and day stalls. Please call Karen at 412-848-3501 to reserve. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.**

REFUNDS:

NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of

illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.

SCHOOLING:

Will be permitted in the main ring **Friday 1:pm-7:pm**, and **until 7:30 am the morning of the show.** Weather permitting.

No lunging in show rings. Lunging in designated areas only.

\$75 schooling fee for non showing horses per day.

Proper show attire is requested. All persons mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet.

There must be 3 in each division at each show to qualify for Series Champion and Reserve.

All dogs must be kept on leashes. Show management has the right to ask that disruptive dogs be removed from the show area.

PARKING:

Please be advised that all parking is on grass. Trucks, trailers and cars must park in designated parking areas in the grass field. Please follow the signs.

ELECTRICITY:

Fans are allowed at \$15 a weekend. Due to limited capacity **NO crockpots, hot plates or any other electrical appliances.**

****DIRECTIONS: PLEASE READ!!**

From I-79 N: Take exit 113. Turn **LEFT** onto Rt 208/258, turn right at Sheetz onto 258 N. Go approx. 1 mile to the first right, Blacktown Rd, and turn right. In ½ mile turn left onto Lee Rd. Fair Haven Farms will be on the right in one mile.

Traveling from either I-80 E or W, DO NOT exit until reaching I-79 South towards Pittsburgh.

From I-79 S: Take exit 113. Turn **RIGHT** onto 208/258. Immediate right at Sheetz onto 258 N. Go approx. 1 mile to the first right, Blacktown Rd, and turn right. In ½ mile, turn left onto Lee Rd. Fair Haven Farms will be on the right in one mile.
