Jumper Class Descriptions

Blue Ribbon Class: You may jump a practice round, each clear trip gets a blue ribbon. Trips may be limited due to time constraints.

Baby Jumper 2': Open to all horses and ponies with very limited experience. Spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Puddle jumper.

Puddle Jumper 2'3: Open to green horses and ponies and/or novice riders. Fences 2'3". Horse/rider combinations in this division can only cross enter into Beginner Jumper, or any eligible hunter/equitation division that follows the back-to-back fence height rule. Horse/rider combinations are only eligible in this division for two-point years. All classes will be held under USEF Optimum Time Table. Excessive speed will be penalized. Jumping combinations will be no less than three strides.

Beginner Jumper 2'6: Open to all horses and riders with limited experience. Fences will be 2'6" with spreads not to exceed the height of the fence. May cross enter into either Puddle or Low Training Jumper, or any eligible hunter/equitation division that follows the back-to-back fence height rule. To be run under USEF specifications set by sanctioned shows..

Low Training Jumper 2'9": Section Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 2'9" with spreads not to exceed fence height. May cross enter into Beginner Jumper or Training Jumper, or any eligible hunter/equitation division that follows the back-to-back fence height rule. To be run under USEF specifications set by sanctioned shows

Training Jumper 3': Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 3' with spreads not to exceed the height of the fence. To be run under USEF specifications set by sanctioned shows. May cross enter into Low Training Jumper or Schooling Jumper, or any eligible hunter/equitation division that follows the back-to-back fence height rule.

Schooling Jumper 3'3": Open to all horses and riders. Fences will be 3'3" with spreads not to exceed the height of the fence. To be run under USEF

specifications set by sanctioned shows. May cross enter into Training Jumper, or any eligible hunter/equitation division that follows the back-to-back fence height rule.

Fair Haven Farms Jumper Mini Prix: The class is open to all riders on horses or ponies. All entries must compete in at least TWO Jumper classes at each show prior to the Jumper Mini Prix. The Fences will be set at a choice of 2'3/2'6/2'9/3' with spreads not to exceed fence heights. A clear trip will return for the jump off. Exclusive ribbons will be awarded through eighth place.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PRE ENTRIES: \$18 /class, \$40 /Fair Haven Farms Mini Prix. Must be postmarked by **Monday** before each show. Pre-entries *must* be accompanied by credit card #.

POST ENTRIES AND ADDS: \$20 /class, \$45 / Fair Haven Farms Mini Prix. If postmarked after the Monday before each show, your entries and adds are welcomed.

Provide your credit card number on your entry.

You must show proof of negative Coggins and Flu/Rhino before back numbers can be issued.

STALLS:

Permanent stalls are available- \$75.00 for weekend (a horse must show both days to reserve a weekend stall or a \$75 non showing fee will be added per day), \$65.00 for overnight, \$50 for day stall. \$20 for day shipper fee. \$75 non showing fee per day,

Shavings are available for \$10/bag. Stabling is limited and must be reserved in advance. Weekend stalls have priority ahead of overnight and day stalls. Please call Karen at 412-848-3501 to reserve. **STALL RESERVATIONS WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL FULL PAYMENT IS RECEIVED. TACK STALLS MAY BE LIMITED.**

REFUNDS:

NO STALL FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, horses which are not shown in classes which they have entered, forfeit their entry fees, except if a horse is injured or becomes ill prior to the class or classes that are being scratched. This must be accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian. In either case above, the entry fees will be refunded less an office processing charge of \$20.00.

SCHOOLING:

Will be permitted in the main ring **Saturday at end of show 7:30 pm**, and **until 7:30 am the morning of the show.** Weather permitting. No lunging in show rings. Lunging in designated areas only. **\$75 schooling fee for non showing horses per day.**

Proper show attire is requested. All persons mounted on a horse must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet.

There must be 3 in each division at each show to qualify for Series Champion.

All dogs must be kept on leashes. Show management has the right to ask that disruptive dogs be removed from the show area.

PARKING:

Please be advised that all parking is on grass. Trucks, trailers and cars must park in designated parking areas in the grass field. Please follow the signs.

ELECTRICITY:

Fans are allowed at \$15 a weekend. Due to limited capacity **NO crockpots**, **hot plates or any other electrical appliances**.

From I-79 N: Take exit 113 Turn <u>left</u> onto Rt 208/258, turn right at Sheetz onto 258 N. Go approx. 1 mile to the first right Blacktown Rd and turn right. In ½ mile turn left onto Lee Rd. Fair Haven Farms will be on the right in one mile.

Traveling from either I-80 E or W, Stay On until I-79 South towards Pittsburgh
